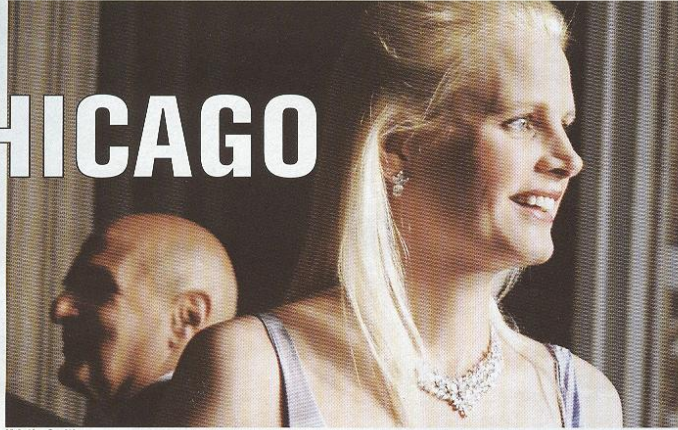


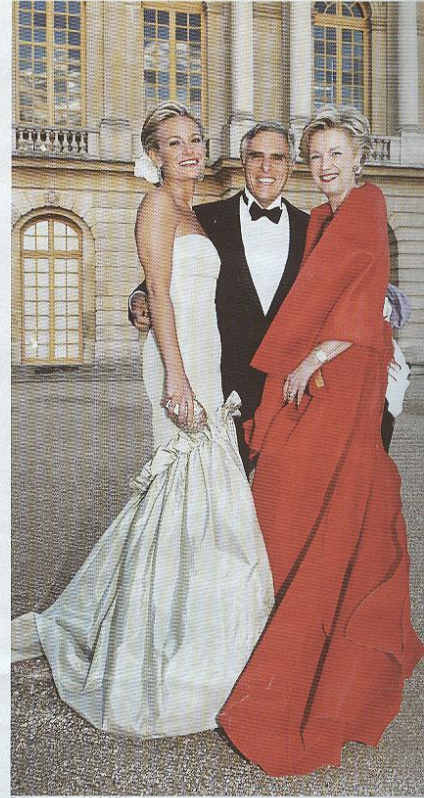
# SCENE IN CHICAGO

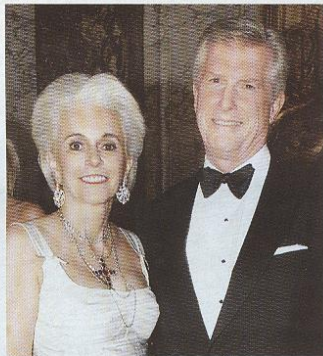
